74 Barolo, 2006 Manfredi £38.00
ITALY ~ Full of character this is a fine Barolo with all the complex flavours you expect - violets, chocolate, and cherry fruit.

75 Mas de la Seranne Cuvée Clos des Immortelles, Coteaux du Languedoc 2007 £40.00
FRANCE ~ Jean-Pierre Venture's blend of Southern French and Rhône grapes has an intense wild herb aroma while the silky smooth palate adds to the joy.

76 Château Musar, Gaston Hochar 2002/03 £44.00
LEBANON ~ A deliciously intense red from a lesser-known wine region. The flavours are almost raisiny in their ripeness and depth.

77 Vina Arana Reserva La Rioja Alta 2001 £46.00
SPAIN ~ A splendid example of a slightly lighter style of Rioja; the rich, complex fruit is leavened by the judicious use of oak to produce a beautifully balanced, smooth wine.

78 Amarone della Valpolicella Classico DOC, 2006, Zeni £55.00
ITALY ~ Amarone is a powerful, concentrated dry red that is properly made from grapes that have been dried in airy barns

79 Château Haut-Batailley 5eme Cru Pauillac 2007 £57.50
FRANCE ~ Very deep crimson in colour and gorgeously delicate dark red fruit on the nose. Medium-bodied, with a silky, noble edge of sweetness and a fine, pure finish that confirm the magnificence of this wine.

80 Gevrey-Chambertin 1er cru Petite Chapelle, René Bouvier 2006 £59.95
FRANCE ~ Petite-Chapelle is next to grand cru Chapelle-Chambertin, and according to Bernard Bouvier its wines have a fragrant Chambolle character. The fruit is predominantly Griottes (small red cherries) but it also has a mineral density.

81 La Réserve de Léoville Barton 2005, St-Julien £65.00
FRANCE ~ The wines of St-Julien are rated by many as the most charming in Bordeaux since they often seem to marry the best qualities of this famous region so charmingly, offering not only power and longevity, but also subtlety, balance and superb blackcurrant fruit notes.

82 Vosnee-Romanée, Domaine Michel Gros 2006 £80.00
FRANCE ~ Twice awarded IWC Red Wine Maker of the Year, Michel Gros makes benchmark Vosne-Romanée at his cellars in the village. Deep colour and a bright perfumed nose are followed by black cherries, spiciness and a satin-like texture.

83 Muscat de St-Jean-de-Minervois, Vignerons de Septimanie £4.50 £15.00
FRANCE ~ From the tiny Southern French village of Saint Jean de Minervois, an unmistakable Muscat. Think of the ripest bunch of raisined grapes squeezed into your glass; deliciously sweet, but not cloying with a kick of lemony acidity.

84 Mitchell Noble Semillon, Clare Valley 2006 £5.10 £17.00
AUSTRALIA ~ A great, full-on, late harvest sweetie with a silky texture and excellent balance. Intensely concentrated tropical fruit flavours dance on the mid-palate. Made by stalwart Clare producers, Andrew and Jane Mitchell.

85 Château Le Fage Monbazillac 2007 £19.00
FRANCE ~ This is a luscious dessert wine, brimming with ripe botrytised fruit, both complex and intense. François Gerardin and son, Benoit, cultivate 40 hectares of rolling vineyard near Bergerac.

86 Paul Cluver Weisser Riesling, Noble Late Harvest, Elgin 2010 £24.00
SOUTH AFRICA ~ 100% botrytis and 130 grammes residual sugar! Marmalade and pineapples, very sweet, lovely balance and great length. A truly superb wine to give the best German Ausleses a run for their money!

87 Tokaji Aszú 5 Puttonyos, Royal Tokaji 2006 - 25cl £29.95
Deliciously sweet dessert wine with a creamy texture and flavours of apricot, orange marmalade, honey and ginger. Carefully selected grapes are blended in the winery in Mád, one of the three most important market towns in the region.

CHILE ~ Crisp and fresh with citrus fruit notes and a twist of melon.

2 Chenin Blanc, Freedom Cross £4.65 £6.20 £12.40 £18.25
SOUTH AFRICA ~ Full and ripe apple flavours mingle with tropical fruit hints; slightly off dry finish.

3 Pinot Grigio, Ca Solare £5.15 £6.70 £13.40 £19.00
ITALY ~ This is a crisply-fruited wine with just a hint of floral aromas and a very subtle touch of honey on the finish.

4 Viognier, Alto Pampas £19.50
ARGENTINA ~ Full bodied wine from the Mendoza region with flavours of ripe apricot fruit.

5 Riesling Kabinett, Moselland £20.00
GERMANY ~ Benchmark that sings with pure apple fruit and floral tones. Peachy palate, off-dry in style and super refreshing acidity.

6 Chardonnay, Rémi & Jérôme £5.20 £6.80 £13.60 £20.00
FRANCE ~ Ripe and balanced with lemony fruit flavours providing lift and a touch of oak to give weight and richness.

7 Rioja Blanco, Marqués de Cáceres £20.00
SPAIN ~ Dry but fruity and very well crafted. A thoroughly modern white Rioja.

8 Muscadet Sèvre-et-Maine, Domaine Fief de la Brie £21.50
FRANCE ~ The best wine from this estate, bigger and fuller-flavoured than your run-of-the-mill Muscadet. Perfect with fish.

9 Sauvignon Blanc, Tumuil Flat £5.50 £7.35 £14.70 £22.00
NEW ZEALAND ~ Classic Kiwi Sauvignon, fresh, crisp, full of gooseberry and nettle fruit with great poise and elegance.

10 Sunnycliff Chardonnay, Victoria £22.00
AUSTRALIA ~ This wine has sheer drinkability, everything is well balanced so one glass is not enough!

11 Mâcon-Villages, Domaine du Puits, Jacques Charlet £23.50
FRANCE ~ Buttery, slightly smoky Chardonnay with attractive, lemony acidity.
